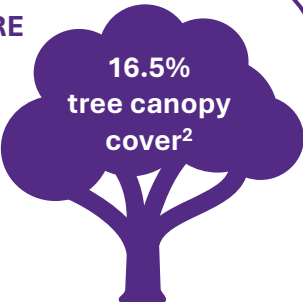


3. GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE
