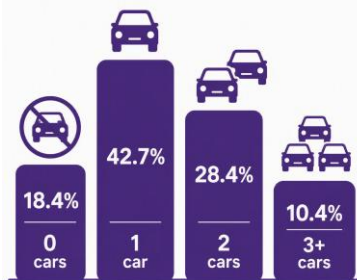
3. TRANSPORT

4. FUTURE CHALLENGES



East Anglia is the driest region in the UK with only **2/3** of the national average rainfall each year⁶

By 2050, our region will have a **593 megalitres** per day deficit of water without interventions⁶
