No viability assessment or development appraisal has been undertaken to date, the site considered viable reflecting its location, adjacent to existing residential development and the position close to the north of the city of Norwich and amenities. It is considered that the land, either in part or as a whole, would be suitable for a mix of housing types. It adjoins an existing residential area to the east with further comprehensive development to the north separated by one field in the same family ownership and which could allow additional development, access being over the beck leading off Horsebeck Way. The additional area of land has been cross hatched in red for identification, both considered suitable for the type of development envisaged and meeting requirements for additional future building land.

As previously noted, the land, in conjunction with an additional area to the north, within the same family ownership, would provide a suitable area for development, in keeping with the locale and matching Beckside to the eastern boundary.
